

JUNIOR CLUB RULES

ERDCC is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. The club believes that it is important that players, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the Club Captain or Club Chairman.

As a member of ERDCC you are expected to abide by the following junior club rules.

- a) All members must play within the rules and respect the umpires and their decisions.
- b) All players must respect their opponents.
- c) All players should keep to agreed timings for training and matches or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- d) All players must wear suitable kit for training sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager. All players shall wear white trousers, suitable sports footwear and a club playing shirt in all match situations. The club strongly recommends that all players use a helmet when batting and has available a stock of very reasonably priced helmets for Junior players available for purchase. All players must wear a groin protector whenever batting or wicketkeeping. All junior members shall wear a club cap or club floppy hat whenever in the field.
- e) All Members must pay any fees for membership or events promptly.
- f) Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- g) Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
